- A. Jonah 1:7-10 - Jonah's False Declaration of Faith
(i) verse 1:9 is self-referential
(ii) verse:10 foreshadows to the sailors declaration of faith
- B. Jonah 1:11-16 - The Sailors True Declaration of Faith
(i) The sailors (Gentiles) extend mercy to Jonah (1:13)
(ii) The sailors declare their faith in the covenant God of Israel (1:14)
(iii) The sailors offer a sacrifice and make vows (1:16)

- A. The Wrong Way to Respond - Obedience to the Lord is begrudging submission
B. The Proper Way to Respond - Obedience to the Lord is freedom
