River of Life's objective is to serve homeless and disadvantaged men in Boise, and lead them to a better life through God's redeeming love.

CITY LIGHT HOME FOR WOMEN & CHILDREN, BOISE

At City Light, we offer a safe haven of hope and love for women and children. We provide emergency services such as meals, shelter, and clothing, as well as education, work-search assistance, mental health counseling, addiction recovery through the New Life Program, and children's programs.

VALLEY WOMEN & CHILDREN'S SHELTER, NAMPA

We strive to provide a safe place for women and children to recover from homelessness. With 66 available beds, our shelter for homeless women and children offers a safe, clean place to sleep, in addition to clothing, meals, and case management.

RESCUE MISSION RECOVERY LODGE, NAMPA

Built to serve the needs of the medically fragile guests, the Recovery Lodge can serve up to 45 homeless individuals at a time.

SONRISE MANOR TRANSITIONAL COMMUNITY, BOISE

Located on Curtis Road, Sunrise Manor will significantly expand our capacity to help people take an intermediate step out of our emergency shelters toward independent living. BRMM is now raising funds to purchase and remodel this facility.

MINISTRY CENTER & WAREHOUSE, BOISE

The hub for all BRMM activities, this facility houses our administrative offices, warehouse, and donation center.
