SERMON NOTES

"Remembrance, Communion and Hope"

1 Cor. 11:17-34

I) Opening - The Lord's Table and Christian Identity

John Calvin's letter to Peter Martyr Vermigli "for although the faithful come into this Communion on the very first day of their calling; nevertheless, inasmuch as the life of Christ increases in them, He daily offers Himself to be enjoyed by them. This is the Communion which they receive in the Sacred Supper."

II) The Three Aspects of Communion

1) We Remember Christ's Death (Past): Exodus 12:43-51; 1 Corinthians 11:17-34

- A) Civic Holidays are memorials to the past.
- B) In the Lord's Supper, we remember what Christ did for us on the cross.

2) We Commune with God in Christ (Present): John 6:22-59

- A) The presence of God in Christ is not an empty symbol. God in Christ is spiritually present with his people.
- B) The illustration in the Christian tradition of the ladder.

3) We Hope in Eternal Life with God Forever (Future): Revelation 19:6-10

- A) The Lord's Supper points towards a glorious future with God forever.
- B) Communion should shape Christians to be heavenly minded people.

III) Conclusion - Preview for next week's sermon and series finale on the benediction in worship.
