**I) Introduction** - The Head of the Body - Reformed,  
Multigenerational, and Missional.

**II) Reformed** - Romans 11:36

A) Westminster Shorter Catechism - What is the chief end of man? To glorify God and to enjoy him forever.

B) The problem? The Lord becomes an instrument to my success. *Not the anchor of my life.*

C) Application: The value of being Reformed in practice (worship), piety (personal relationship with the Lord), and polity (church government).

**III) Multigenerational** – Duet. 7:6-11

A) What does "generations" mean in Duet. 7:6-11

B) What problem? Monogenerational not multigenerational

C) Application: Building use moving forward at Christ Presbyterian Church

**IV) Missional** - Matthew 28:16-20

A) Let's always make the Lord's mission to save and redeem as our first priority here at Christ Presbyterian Church

B) The problem? We focus on great individuals winning people to Christ as opposed to the church body.

C) Application - It takes the entire body of Christ to see a profession of faith. In children and adults!

**V) Conclusion** - Recap and preview for the heart of the body of Christ. The heart of Christ Presbyterian Church is to deepen our walk with Christ through prayer, perseverance, all by the power of the Spirit.
