I) Introduction - Immersed in a World of Consumerism and Recap of Series

II) Exodus 20:17 - What does "covet" mean?

A) An action - The commandment only applies to outward behavior.

B) Desire - The prohibition is placed upon desiring obsessively over objects.

III) The Problem (recap of series)? Christians do not understand the nuances of the law in the Christian life.

IV) Application - Ephesians 2:1-10

A) The law produces death works from a heart of stone.

B) The gospel gives life. We are united to the one who kept the law perfectly.

C) Christians receive a heart transplant. The Spirit empowers good works in the Christian's life. Transformation does occur.

V) Conclusion - Pray for General Assembly 2024 and reminder that Michael will preach next week on Psalm 1.
